8th Grade Girls / 2 mile: Asap (could be combined with 8 grade boys if numbers are small)

8th Grade Boys / 2 mile: Asap

High School Schedule:

Varsity Girls 5K (Will not start before 4 pm)

Team Parking: Please park team buses/vans in the lot in 6th Street Park and enter OFF 6th STREET. Team Parking will close at 2:45 pm for runner safety and then re-open after the meet concludes.

Spectator Parking: No Spectator Parking will be allowed in 6th Street Park. Spectators will need to park outside the park and walk in.

Restroom Facilities: Are extremely limited. There is a restroom in the northwest corner of 6th Street Park.

Starting Procedure: Regular Starting Procedures

Timing: Runners will be timed up through the following times. Runners not completing the race by this time will need to get their time from their coach. 1 mile - 10 minutes, 2 miles - 22 minutes, 5K - 28 minutes.

Finish Line Procedure: Numbers of runners will be recorded and tags will be pulled.

Awards - There will be NO awards ceremony. All medals will be handed out in the chute. Team medals will be available at the finish line tent.
