EVENT: 7th & 8th Grade Football with Comanche

DATE/TIME: Thursday, September 3, 2020 beginning at 4:00 p.m.

LOCATION: Seymour Rogers Middle School, 721 Griffith, Liberal, KS

ORDER OF PLAY: ARTICLE I - FOOTBALL:

1. A minimum of three officials are to be used preferably 4 if possible.
2. The length of the quarters will be the same (8 minutes).
3. It is required that half time be ten (10) minutes long for all teams. This *does not* include the mandatory 3-minute warm-up.
4. In the case of a tie at the end of regulation, the KSHSAA overtime procedure will be followed. Coin toss will determine the choice of offense or defense to begin the overtime period. Offense will begin on the 10-yard line and the team will have 4 plays to score. If there is a turnover, that concludes that team's offensive possession. This procedure continues until one team scores more than the other team in equal possessions.
5. *When two games are to be played, there will be no less than 10 minutes between games.*
6. Order of play and 5th quarter football games - order of play will be 7A first followed by both 7B and 8B 5th quarters. Use officials if possible. No kickoff. No rushed punts. Coaches can be in the huddle. Start on 35 yard line. 20 minute running clock, 10 minutes each team offense/defense, 7th and 8th separate (when possible) with field split 7th on one end and 8th on the other.
The decision whether or not there is enough players to have a "B team" game must be decided by the Friday prior to the scheduled game.
7. The league champion will be determined by each team's league record. The league champion team will receive a plaque.
8. A running clock will be in effect in the second half if at any point the score differential reaches 30 points and will be in effect for the remainder of the game. (KSHSAA "Mercy Rule")
9. **Conference Champion will be determined by:**
 1. Best record in conference play
 2. Tie in win-loss record between two teams is broken by head to head competition.
 3. If more than two teams are tied in win-loss record - (1) head to head competition determines winner; (2) if tie cannot be broken by head to head competition, all three teams will tie for the conference championship.

FIFTH QUARTER: *No Fifth Quarter will be played.*

BUSES/PARKING: Parking will be in the parking lot on the West side of SRMS, Please drop teams off at the back of our school (west side of the building). From Hwy. 54 turn south on Seward Ave. then turn East on E. Hickory and continue straight into the shared parking lot for PVE and SRMS.

2020 - 2021 Special Information

USD #480 Liberal Public Schools have enacted COVID related safety measures including a mask mandate inside all buildings and facilities. Here are the following rules and how they will affect SRMS athletics -

1. Masks or Face Coverings must be worn by ALL individuals, athletes and spectators, upon entry into the building.
2. Once players are on the game floor / field, masks or face coverings do not need to be worn. Masks or Face Coverings need to be worn when on bench / sidelines for substitutes.
3. Masks will be provided for those that do not have one.
4. Spectators entering the gymnasium will have their temperature checked when entering the building.
5. Social Distancing of 6 feet is required for fans. Seating in the gymnasium and football field will be at a limited capacity (Football stadium seating is 275, Gym seating 84) Family members/members of the same household may congregate together.
6. "Throughout all public or private K-12 school buildings or facilities individuals shall maintain a 6-foot distance from other individuals with only infrequent or incidental moments of closer proximity." from executive order 2059.
